SHPD OFFICER SWORN IN AS A FEDERAL TASK FORCE OFFICER FOR THE FBI

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – (South Haven, Michigan) The City of South Haven is proud to announce that Sgt. Pat Carlotto has been selected to serve on a Federal Task Force led by the FBI.

The Federal Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional agency and includes officers from municipalities, counties and the State of Michigan. Officers of the task force have top secret access and resources available beyond what local agencies have to offer.

Police Chief Natalie Thompson was notified by the FBI St. Joseph office that they were seeking additional officers to join the task force. After the opportunity was posted at the SHPD and interviews conducted, Sgt. Carlotto

was selected and sworn in. The FBI pays Sgt. Carlotto's overtime while working as a task force officer. Sgt. Carlotto continues to work regular hours at the SHPD.

"This is not only positive news for Sgt. Carlotto but also for the City of South Haven," states Police Chief Thompson. "The Department now has additional resources to help investigate significant felony cases and Sgt. Carlotto brings additional experience to the force."



Sgt. Carlotto has over seventeen years' experience including three years with SWET and the last seven years with SWAT. He joined the SHPD as a seasonal officer in 1999 and became a full-time officer in February of 2000, and a sergeant in 2005.
