

Golf Carts:

Golf Carts may only operate in the following manner:

- May operate on city street from April 15 to October 15
- Operator must be at least 16 years old and be licensed to operate a motor vehicle
- Comply with signaling requirements of 257.648
 - o If the golf cart has no mechanical or electrical signal – operator must signal using hand and arm movements:
 - ☐ For a left turn, the operator extends the left hand and arm horizontally
 - ☐ For a right turn, the operator extends the left hand and arm upward
- Drive as far to the right of the roadway as practicable
- Not operate on a state trunk line highway (Lagrange, Broadway, Phoenix Streets)
- Not operate on sidewalks or non-motorized trails
- Not to exceed 15 mph
- Not operate on a street with a speed limit of more than 30 mph except to cross that highway or street
- Not operate from ½ before sunset to ½ hour before sunrise
- Must be registered with and display a tag issued by the South Haven Police Department

See the attached Speed Limit Map: Operation on streets colored green (15 & 25 mph) and purple (30 mph).

ORVs:

An ORV is defined as motor-driven off-road recreation vehicle that is a side-saddle 4-wheel vehicle equipped with a Roll-Over Protective Structure (ROPS). An ORV is not a golf cart, registered snowmobile, multi-track or multi-wheel drive vehicle, ATV, motorcycle, or related 2-wheel, 3-wheel, or 6-wheel conveyance.

ORVs may only operate in the following manner:

- Hours of operation:
 - o May 1 to October 31 – 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
 - o November 1 to April 30 – 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Age of Operators:
 - o Operators over the age of 18 must have valid driver license in their immediate possession

- o Operators under the age of 18 must have (1) a valid driver license or (2) be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian AND have an ORV safety certificate issued under MDNR in their immediate possession.
- o No operators under age of 12
 - Manner of Operation
- o ORVs may not exceed 25 miles per hour
- o May not be operated on any state trunk line (Phoenix Street, Broadway, Lagrange as part of I-196BL) except to cross the street
- o Must be driven on the extreme far right of the maintained portion of the street in single file
- o May not be driven in cemeteries, beaches, sidewalks, and non-motorized trails.
- o Must display a lighted headlight and lighted taillight at all times and have a braking system capable of producing deceleration at 14 feet per second on level ground at a speed of 20 mph.
- o Must not transport any passenger unless manufactured for transporting passengers.
- o Operators and passengers must wear a crash helmet and protective eyewear unless individuals are wearing safety belt and the vehicle has roof that meets DOT standards for crash helmets.
