

Bailey Nature Guide, Liberty Hyde Bailey Museum

The City of South Haven is seeking to hire three or four Nature Guides to assist with the Bailey's Budding Naturalists Summer Camp. The positions will be part-time (20-25 hours per week) starting mid-June through the first week of August. Rate of pay is \$11.00 per hour.

Bailey's Budding Naturalists Summer Camp introduces children to the wonders of our natural world. We provide engaging, hands-on learning experiences at our historical museum campus and local summer school programs. We are seeking energetic, responsible Nature Guides to provide an exciting and memorable experience for our campers (age 6-11). Ideal candidates will have a genuine interest in nature or science. Applicants should be patient and fun-loving – experience working with children is a must. Duties require being outdoors in all weather conditions. Responsibilities include preparing learning spaces (indoors/outdoors) and setting up materials, including lifting and carrying supplies. Nature Guides will lead campers through daily activities (scavenger hunts, art activities, nature hikes, exploring creatures, yoga class, etc.) as well as facilitate minimal food preparation and clean-up. Location of our program changes so reliable transportation is a must.

This position is open to high school students entering their senior year in the Fall of 2018 as well as to other candidates who have, at a minimum, completed high school.
